

Web Programmer/Developer Position Announcement

Position

Dr. June Ahn and Dr. Brian Butler (College of Information Studies, College of Education, HCIL) are looking for a programmer/developer in the Open Communities for Education and Learning (OCEL) project. The developer will assist in a project exploring large-scale, open education and learning in the Peer 2 Peer University (P2PU). This is a 1-year position that can be structured as an hourly paid position or a graduate assistantship.

Responsibilities

The developer will assist with the following:

- Interface with P2PU staff and community to facilitate the periodic acquisition and management of data from the platform
- Creation of organizational policies, routines, and processes to facilitate the open sharing of P2PU data to the research community, taking into account issues of ethics and privacy
- Data administration and management, data cleaning, and dataset creation from P2PU data
- Programming and development on the P2PU platform to support design experiments and studies conducted in the online community
- Scholarly activities including literature reviews, research, data analysis, and scholarly writing
- Other tasks as assigned

Requirements and Qualifications

- Prior web development and programming experience (Python/Django etc.),
- Experience contributing to open source projects (familiarity with P2PU and its open source platform Lernanta in particular is a plus)
- Experience with database administration and management (e.g. MySQL, Access etc.)
- Excellent communication skills (written and oral)
- Ability to work well independently, under rapid deadlines, and as part of a team

Compensation

- This position can be structured as an hourly paid position or graduate assistantship (stipend, tuition remission, and benefits). Please indicate which you might prefer when applying and your hourly rate.
