1. Title and abstract (300 – 600 words) of the proposed paper should be submitted **by e-mail** [inf nauk2013@gmail.com](mailto:inf nauk2013@gmail.com) **until 30 December 2012**
2. Notification of acceptance (in the form of a paper or poster) will be passed to authors **by 15 February 2013**
3. Full text of the paper should be sent by e-mail until **12 April 2013**. Articles selected on the base of reviews will be placed in a post-conference publication. Detailed guidance for the authors will be transferred along with the information about the acceptance of the paper.
4. Estimated time of the paper presentation: **15 minutes**
