Applicants should have a PhD in Chemical Engineering or closely related engineering discipline and have research interests in areas related to process systems engineering. In special cases, outstanding candidates in other engineering areas will also be considered.

The Department has a high reputation in both research and teaching, as one of the top schools for Chemical Engineering in Canada. There are a total of eighteen faculty members mainly in the three focus research areas: process systems engineering, polymer science & engineering, and biomaterials & bioprocessing engineering. We are establishing a fourth focus on wastewater related to energy and health issues.

The successful candidate will have the opportunity to participate in the McMaster Advanced Control Consortium with existing faculty and its many multi-national corporate collaborators. The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to teaching in both our graduate and undergraduate programs and to develop a strong research program.
